

MONITOR SERIES MODELS RDM1, RDM2, RDM3

The Monitor Series RDM1 and 2 were high quality loudspeakers designed to be equally suitable for home use or for near-field monitoring. Using Reference Series parts in an attractive cabinet with high gloss side panels they followed on from the highly regarded Reference Series Models 101/3 and 102/2, and benefited from KEF's involvement in the studio-monitoring arena which included the Professional Series models KM1 and P60, and the BBC designed LS5/1A and LS3/5A. The KEF Uni-Q point source array is ideal for monitors due to its even power response and highly detailed stereo imaging. Both systems could be used equally well when mounted on their sides, for example, on a monitoring desk, due to the symmetry of the Uni-Q radiation pattern. The range was later supplemented by the floor standing RDM3.

Monitor Series RDM1 (1996-2000)

RDM1 was a compact two-way closed box system using a long throw version of the 165mm (6.5 inch) Uni-Q array from the Reference Series. It produced a clean, detailed and consistently smooth sound — a prerequisite for extended listening sessions.

Monitor Series RDM2 (1996-2000)

RDM2 was a compact two-way reflex system using a long throw version of the 165mm (6.5 inch) Uni-Q array from the Reference Series Model 100. It produced a clean, detailed and consistently smooth sound — a prerequisite for extended listening sessions. The reflex loading allowed a higher sensitivity and output capability compared to the RDM1 and both systems could be used equally well when mounted on their sides, for example, on a monitoring desk, due to the symmetry of the Uni-Q radiation pattern.

Monitor Series RDM3 (1997-2000)

RDM3 was a slim floor standing three-way design using the new B169 racetrack bass driver in a reflex enclosure. It offered the sonic values of the RDM1 and 2 with extended bass response, higher output capability and a domestically pleasing enclosure.

RDM two

Magnetically shielded for home theatre capability, RDM two is a full two-way bass reflex bookshelf loudspeaker with 175W power handling, impressive dynamic range and characteristic Monitor Series accuracy. The 160mm (6½") Uni-Q® bass/midrange driver incorporates KEF's legendary 25mm (1") fabric dome tweeter, and like RDM one, it is suitable for mounting either vertically or horizontally. Cherry wood or red lacquer finish.

The remarkable musicality of the RDM one marks it out as a natural for hi-fi or near field monitor applications. Built to Reference Series standards, the two-way sealed box design features a coincident source 160mm Uni-Q® bass/midrange driver, delivering an intricately detailed acoustic image over an unusually wide listening area. As with all Monitor Series speakers, thick bevel-edged side panels add a distinctive finishing touch.
